Visit as many of these churches as you can, getting sponsored to do so.

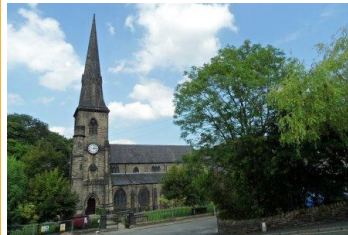
